From Ann Arbor: I94W to exit 157(Pierce Rd and Old 12)

Turn left at stoplight for Norvell Rd/Sarossy Lake Rd and left at second drive

From Jackson: I94 E to exit 150 (Mt Hope Rd)  
Turn right off 94 and go south 2.5 miles to stoplight  
Turn left onto Michigan Ave, continue one mile  
At stoplight for Norvell/Sarossy Lake Road, turn right  
Left at second drive

Dear Pet Owner,

Your veterinarian has referred you and your pet to Dr. Ruth Barthel. At your consultation she will examine your pet and talk to you about the dental therapy and treatment available to you and your pet.

After your pet's oral exam, Dr. Barthel will talk with you about her findings and the recommendations she has for your pet. Please feel free to ask any questions you may have, and let her know of any concerns that she can help you with regarding the therapy and home care for your pet. She will be happy to create a personalized treatment plan for your pet's oral health and well-being. Your veterinarian will be kept informed of your pet's treatment by letter, and when possible, by phone. Please be sure that your veterinarian's name and address is given to our receptionist so that we may forward all reports promptly.

Although Dr. Barthel will be seeing your pet within a general hospital setting, only treatment and medications related to your pet's dental health would be provided. Your pet's doctor, who is familiar with your pet's history, best handles any questions you have regarding general veterinary care. Referring your pet to us shows that your veterinarian has a high level of concern for your pet's health and well-being.

**Directions:**

from Ann Arbor: I94 W to exit 157 (Pierce Rd and Old 12)  
Turn left off 94, go south 7 miles on Old 12  
Turn left at Norvell Rd (it has a full stoplight)  
Left at second drive

**From Jackson:**

I94 E to exit 150 (Mt. Hope Rd.)  
Go south about 2.5 miles until you reach the stoplight  
Turn left at the stoplight (Michigan Ave.)  
Continue about one mile, to stoplight. This is Norvell Rd, turn right  
Left at second drive.
